

# Developments 2013-14: guidance for university admissions tutors on English Language





Option Internationale du Baccalauréat (OIB) – France (British Option): English Language and Literature A Guide for University Admissions Tutors

Candidates for the OIB British Option take **first language (English) examinations** in English Language and Literature and History-Geography, in addition to the standard subjects of the French Baccalaureate.

What do the <u>OIB English Language and Literature examinations</u> tell an Admissions Tutor about the candidate's level of achievement in English?

The OIB English Language and Literature examinations are first language examinations. The literature component is examined and assessed at a level equivalent to A-level English Literature, and language is assessed by reference to appropriate educated mother tongue usage. The linguistic demands of these exams are focused on the use of English in an academic context; this makes them an excellent preparation for university





Cambridge Associate

- ASIBA administers IGCSEs
- No CIE annual registration fee, previously:
  - €1,180 state-subsidised centres
  - €5,900 independent centres
- ASIBA administrative charge: €25 per candidate per entry, capped at €1,000


