Strategy 1: find new sources of revenue



Cambridge Associate

IGCSE administration fees from 2022

- 30€ per candidate per entry (capped at €1,500 for OIB schools)
- Saving of up to €6000 per year per school

Strategy 2: mutualise the burden across <u>all</u> those who benefit

New membership fee structure introduced 2021/22 to cover:
Inspectors' training fees and expenses
Website - OIB handbook
Assistant Moderators' expenses &
Examiners' lunches
Administrative Assistance



Resolution on membership fees 2021

- an increase in the annual membership fee from €10 per *Terminale* student to €12.50 (with a cap of €1,500) and
- an increase in the minimum fee from €250 to €300.
- To be reviewed during the academic year
 2021-22 no change 2022/23
