FUNDING AND SCHOLARSHIPS

IB scholarship

£2,000 award if you've obtained 34 points or more in the International Baccalaureate.

Non-EU Europe scholarships

Awards of £5,000 are available through this scheme for undergraduate students.

EU scholarships are also available worth up to £8,000 depending on your level of study.

Academic Excellence International Masters Scholarships

Awards of £4,000 are available through this scheme for postgraduate students achieving a CGPA 3.00+ OR 75% or above in their undergraduate degree.

MBA Scholarships worth up to 100% of the tuition fee are also available.
